### How does the program work?

The CNA "We Did It" Program is a one-time cash award program designed to celebrate success and to support CNA members who have successfully received a high school diploma (or equivalent), post-secondary 1-year certificate/diploma, post-secondary diploma, or degree (two year minimum), and/or each level of trade red seal trades certification. The CNA Bursaries are a celebration of great accomplishment and are meant to encourage further education skills development.
