Teck Indigenous Award

This award will be distributed annually to student(s) attending a post-secondary institution with demonstrated financial need for contribution to education costs. Preference will be given to students in Teck's communities of interest; however, if there are no eligible recipients in a given year from these communities, students living in British Columbia, Alberta, Ontario, Newfoundland and the Yukon will be considered.

Awards Criteria:

Awards Category: Post-Secondary Education

Program of Study: Preference will be given to business, engineering, specifically materials, process, mechanical, chemical and electrical engineering, earth sciences, and environmental studies.

Trades programs that meet the bursary criteria which should be considered include: heavy duty mechanic, electrician, welder, instrumentation technician.

Level of Study: Post-secondary education, technical training or development programs

Indigenous Affiliation: Any

Other: Students must be from communities where Teck has operations.

Application Deadlines: August 1, November 1, February 1.
