- Familiar with field level hazard assessments,
- Experience and knowledge within a civil construction environment,
- Experience and knowledge of gravel pit / quarry operations would be an asset for this position,
- Willingness to support site operations through manual labour, including shoveling, operating powered equipment, loading, and unloading of miscellaneous supplies and equipment, light maintenance, and other duties as needed,
- Willingness to complete onboarding, electronic logs, and forms,
