JOB SUMMARY

A Civil Construction Superintendent is responsible for overseeing construction projects from start to finish. - Prior experience as a heavy equipment operator, pipe layer, etc.
- Valid Unrestricted Drivers License (heavy Trailer Endorsement or Class 1 Preferred)
- Valid Safety Certifications, WHMIS, CSTS2020, H2S, Ground Disturbance, Fall Protection, TDG, OFA 1 w/Transportation Endorsement
- Ability to Pass pre-employment drug testing.
