- Maintain comprehensive training and equipment certification records for reporting and legal compliance
- Inspect and maintain fire-fighting and fire suppression equipment as per the regulatory and insurance provider requirements
- Provide subject matter expertise in areas of risk and emergency response to auditors, inspectors, and regulatory agencies
- Develop the THVCP Mine Emergency Response Plan (MERP), participate or conduct required annual emergency response plans tabletop drills for site partners and support these work groups throughout project planning and execution as needed

- Certificate, Diploma, or Degree in Health and Safety or Emergency Response would be considered an asset
- Knowledge of relevant regulations pertaining to emergency response, fire protection, and rope rescue
- First Aid Instructor Certification and background in various levels of training
- Minimum five years of relevant emergency response or mine rescue experience
